

Application Guidelines for the 2019 Ehime University Biological Science Award

◎ What is the “Ehime University Biological Science Award”?

This is an award established in 2019 based on a donation by Professor Satoru Suzuki to the “Ehime University Young Researcher Fund”. Prof. Satoru Suzuki of the Center for Marine Environmental Studies at Ehime University, made the donation to encourage young researchers conducting creative research in the field of biological science and its related areas.

1 Objective

To commend and encourage young researchers who can be expected to be active internationally in the field of biological science and its related areas.

2 Target

Individuals, below the age of 40 on March 31, 2020, who are currently engaged in research in a broad range of bioscience-related fields and who fall under any of the following, and who show promise as a researcher in the future.

- (1) Those who are in the doctoral program at Ehime University
- (2) Those who are employed (full-time or part-time) by Ehime University
- (3) Those who graduated from Ehime University and are currently employed by an institution other than Ehime University

4 Award

Certificate of award, commemorative gift, research grant (100,000 yen)

* The research grant is provided under the following conditions:

- (1) It shall be used for the awardee’s research.
- (2) The awardee’s affiliation shall be responsible for the accounting.

5 Application method

- (1) Recommendation not required
- (2) Documents to be submitted

2. List of academic achievements in the last 5 years

- Create a list classified according to the following categories of academic achievement
 - Original paper (Please append the latest impact factors of the journals listed)
 - Books (limited to those for sale at a bookstore or online etc.)
 - Other works (Scientific proceedings, journals, bulletins, reports, etc.)
 - International conference presentations (limited to oral presentations made by the applicant)
- Add doi or URL so that the materials can be read on the internet, or attach a PDF file

3 Original research proposal

- A4 size (horizontal writing), within 2 pages including texts and pictures
